B) Please check the stop saws after use to make sure that they aren't clogged up with pieces of wood – if they are please clean them out. There are ways to keep this from happening – Tape over blade area. Dave B. presented new procedure for table saw to stop small slivers of wood from clogging the suction system. The blade plate cover is to be removed and left off for next user. This requires everyone to check the condition down around the blade for clogs, scraps and sawdust. The Maintenance crew fixes saws, it doesn't clean saws.

C) Floor Managers – PLEASE check the vacuums on your watch – often they are left completely clogged

D) Lathe users: – periodically sweep the walkway when you are working so that people don't slip on the debris
