

## **BASIC BOWL TURNING Lathe II**

Instructors — Jim Sloan, Paul Allen, Jim Casey, Art Lincoln, Bill Zurcher and Linda Serda

**Prerequisite:** Lathe I or instructor's assessment

**Enrollment:** Limited to three students per class, with a minimum of one

**Schedule:** 3 hours — there is a new class each month (verify dates and times using online wood club monthly calendar)

**Student Materials to Buy & Prepare Prior to Class:** None — instructors will prepare the needed material for each student

**Description:** This is a class which applies the techniques of the Basic Lathe I instruction to bowl turning. The topics to be covered are:

- Getting started, review all basics
- Tools - bowl gouge, scrapers, parting tool – tool orientation and sharpening angles
- Grain and cutting direction, tool control
- Mounting and cutting bowl bottom
- Cutting the top and finishing the bottom
- Design elements

Each participant will practice turning a square blank into a small bowl.

**Fee:** \$15 — this includes the instructor provided wood.

**Tools** will be provided, but student may their bring their own to use and to verify sharpening angles
