

Make a Stool, Learn a Tool...

Instructor: Bob Simmons; The Hand Tool Guy

Prerequisites: None

Schedule: This unique class consists of three separate Tuesdays, starting April 25th, followed by May 9th, and May 16th, 2:00pm-6:00pm. Each class is four hours in length. There will be homework after each class.

Student Supplied Materials: None

Enrollment: Minimum 1 person / Maximum 2 persons

Description: The purpose of this class is to introduce the participants to the use of selected hand tools in shaping wood and the hand brace & bit in drilling holes. Task specific hand tools will be used to create tapered mortise & tenon joints. The end product is a 4-legged stool with a solid top built using Windsor Chair technology. Individual work is required between sessions.

Fee: \$10 plus cost of materials provided by the instructor. Estimated cost for materials is \$25 for a total of \$35.
