**Maintenance**, Art Lincoln. If you haven't attended a Thursday night to watch maintenance replace all the sand paper, you should. We are having machines out of order within a couple of days of the brand new sand paper being installed. Please don't crank real hard when you are using the machines. Every time we paper a machine it's about \$25. Remember that just because your glue looks cured, it may not be fully cured and can still gum up the sanding machines. Also please use the magnet and the moisture meter to check your wood before you are using the table saws to avoid firing and then paying for a saw stop. We use Peterman's for lumber, they have a large yard. Please check the lumber that we sell, often times they will have staples from the plastic wrap they are transported with. When using the spindle sanders, they do not need to be super tight, just snugged up with the wrenches, carefully and slowly put new spindles in to avoid gumming them up.

**Safety**, Bob Simmons. Stop the shop has been well attended. Sanding machines have been taking a beating over the last month. If you don't know how to properly use a piece of equipment, please ask for help.

**President**, Art Lincoln. I'm doing my best to keep club email blasts short and sweet. If you are not getting the emails, please let us know so we can check your addresses.
