

Lathe - Natural Edge Bowl



Instructors — Bill Kram, Stan Brown

Prerequisite: This is an advanced class for intermediate level turners

Enrollment: Limited to three students per class, with a minimum of two

Schedule: 3 hours — there is a new class each month (verify dates and times using online wood club monthly calendar)

Student Materials to Buy & Prepare: None — instructors will prepare the needed material for each student.

Description: Natural edge bowls are unique in using the contour of the bark side of a log as the top rim of the bowl

The topics to be covered are:

- Tools - Bowl gouge, round nose scraper, diamond parting tool
- Blank preparation
- Mounting between centers to balance the form.
- Techniques to retain the bark edge.

Fee: \$15 — this includes the instructor provided wood.

Tools will be provided, but students may bring their own to use and to verify sharpening angles.
